She is the Co-Founder and International Coordinator of the worldwide STEM project "Innovate your dreams". Her project will teach 3 out of the 17 United Nations' Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) described in the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development. This project has a far-reaching impact since educationists from over 60 countries have been nominated as coordinators representing their country and over 100.000 students and over 2000 teachers and schools have so far registered. The project is starting to become a global educational movement uniting children and adults from all over the world.

Furthermore, she acted as a flexible zone teacher of the 4th Primary School of Artemida, (Greece) in the program "Playing with Protons", a science education program organized by the CMS experiment, one of CERN's Large Hadron Collider (LHC) experiments.

For her projects she was awarded with many national and international awards and prizes. Due to financial crisis she spent 2500 euros for her project to give her children the best learning opportunity & experiences.
